



SECURITY COMMITTEE ALERT #3

Hammock Dunes Alert #3:

A rash of burglaries is affecting multiple communities in our area; Hammock Dunes, Sea Colony, Grand Haven, Plantation Bay, Halifax Plantation and others. The Flagler County Sheriff's Office has assigned a task force of detectives to investigate these crimes. We are working with them hand in hand every day. Since the investigation is active and on-going, the information that can be released is limited. The common element with the Hammock Dunes burglaries is that none were forced entry, which means doors were left unlocked or open.

The following are steps that are being put in place to ensure Hammock Dunes has safe and secure vehicular access control:

- The South Gate hours are now 7am - 11pm Monday - Friday. 8am - 11pm on Saturday & Sunday.
- The main gate and Island Estates gate is still 24 hours.
- All vendors/visitors that enter through the vendor lane will have their driver's license scanned. All passengers will be required to have their photo identification scanned and/or their name recorded.
- The Hammock Dunes North Gate code box will be temporarily shut down.
- Two additional gate officers will rotate from 8am - 4pm between the Main Gate, North Gate, South Gate, Island

Estates Gate, & Mariner's Drive Gate.

- Pedestrians and bicyclists will be questioned as needed.

Please remember transponders are for Hammock Dunes residents only! If a vendor or contractor is identified as having a transponder, it will be deactivated.

Make sure that when you're home or when you leave your home, for any reason, you remain vigilant secure your home. Check to see if you have locked doors, windows, set your alarm if you have one, and closed your garage doors.
